Japan Climate Initiative

A coalition of Japanese non-state actors who are playing active roles in addressing climate change to realize the decarbonized society. JCI includes companies, local governments, chambers of commerce and industry, universities, think tanks, environmental NPOs / NGOs, religious groups, consumer groups, a bar association etc.

Launch: July 6th, 2018

Members: Started with **105** members, and increased to **671** members (492 companies, 37 local govts and 142 other orgs, as of Oct 7, 2021)
